The Róma Hall can be separated in two sections if needed. Pest Hall can be connected to the adjacent Buda Hall to create a large 170 m² room.

Esztergom Hall

The Esztergom Hall stands out as one of the most impressive and spacious halls of the Event Centre. The 200 m² event hall on the ground floor has natural light, terrace connection, exits opening to several sides, additional 135 m² connected rooms and is equipped with full conference technology. It is perfect for large-scale corporate conferences and presentations.

Róma Hall

The Róma Hall is the largest room in the D50 Hotel, located on the ground floor. The 350 m² hall features a private entrance and plenty of natural light, creating a bright and spacious atmosphere. Its modern technical equipment and flexible design make it ideal for hosting large-scale events, such as weddings. If needed, the hall can be divided into two smaller sections. For the convenience of guests, parking is available directly in front of the hall.



Óbuda Hall

The Óbuda Hall is located on the 2nd floor. The 60 m² section hall has natural light and is equipped with mobile conference technology. Due to its size and capabilities, it can be a great venue for trainings, education, workshops, and business meetings.



Pest and Buda Hall

Located on the -1st floor the Pest-Buda Hall joined together by two rooms is an ideal venue for smaller conferences and also a great choice for additional panel discussions, training sessions, lectures or lunches and dinners either joined together or used separately.





Pasarét Community House

The Pasarét Community House is a modern, four-storey building with a unique architecture award-winning design, well-equipped with rooms of varying sizes which are perfect for professional conferences, panel discussions, cultural programmes, or even small theatre productions. From February 2023, the House is considered a certified barrier-free building, where all rooms are accessible to guests with wheelchairs, walkers and assistance dogs.

Szent László Community House

Surrounded by beautiful greenery, the elegant 200 m2 upstairs banqueting hall of the St. László Community House is a unique venue for conferences, lectures, training courses and cultural events. It is a popular venue for concerts due to its perfect acoustics; a Steinway piano is also available in the room. The hall is equipped with a projection screen, a projector and a modern sound system. The Ceremonial Hall seats 145 people in theatre-style, 100 in school-style arrangement, 122 in a round table arrangement and 58 in a U-shape. The ground floor section room and lounge are perfect for training, education, and business meetings. The location is easily accessible by public transport, has 8 private parking spaces, and parking is free in the area.

A total of 5 rooms of various sizes, open- or multi-plan (up to 300 people), provide a venue for your event with outstanding gastronomic service.

St. Stephen's Conference Room

The largest room on the ground floor of the building, this multifunctional room can be divided into three sections by a soundproof wall.

Grand auditorium

A room with a fixed row of chairs is the ideal venue for professional presentations, small conferences, and training courses.

Mindszenty Event Hall

A spacious, multi-plan room designed for exhibitions, conferences, team building, presentations or standing receptions.





Reception Room

The Reception Room is the perfect venue for small lectures, training sessions and civil ceremonies.



Ceremonial Hall

Decorated with beautiful paintings and huge crystal chandeliers, the first floor Ceremonial Hall is the most elegant room in the centre.



Prímás Cellar

With a capacity of nearly 400 people, the Prímás (Primate's) Cellar and Wine Tunnel is a special choice of venue for any occasion, with an atmosphere that is sure to amaze. The unique complex is the same age as the current Cathedral, with a cellar system of almost 3,000 square metres and breathtaking architecture that goes beyond classic restaurants.

Wine tunnel

The nearly 42 m long wine tunnel has a 9 m high ceiling, stacked brick arches and unique lighting, giving it a special atmosphere.

Gallery

The intimate gallery, with its unique architecture, is the ideal venue for smaller, private events.



Hotel Adalbert ***

Both buildings of the hotel are located in the heart of Esztergom at the foot of the Basilica and the Castle Hill. There are several smaller rooms in the Hotel Adalbert St. Thomas House, which serve as the perfect venue for business meetings.

Café Rondella

From the terrace adjacent to the monumental statue of Miklós Melocco depicting the Coronation of St. Stephen, you can enjoy the view of the Esztergom Basilica from up close. The panoramic terrace can seat 20 people, the indoor hall 24 people and the lower terrace 36 people, making it a perfect venue for business breakfasts and smaller receptions.





Special event venues

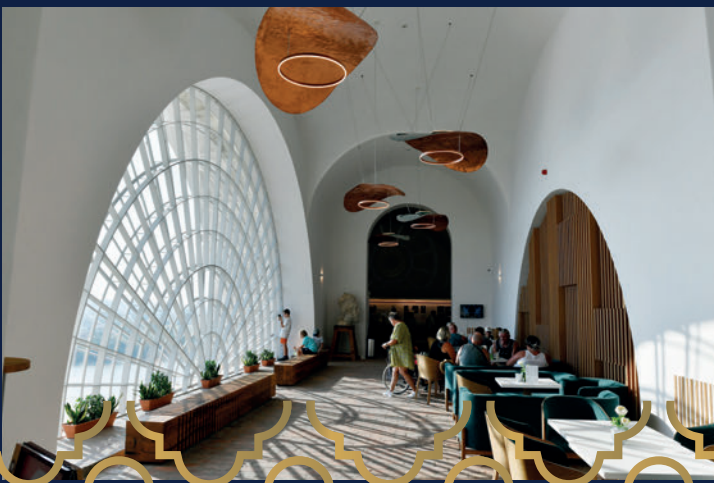
Panorama Café of Esztergom Basilica

On the west side of the basilica, facing the Danube, the imposing space on the second-floor level is named after its huge round-arched window with a magnificent view. It features a café and temporary exhibitions. The space is particularly suitable for cultural programmes, performances, and small-scale events.



Matthias Church Gallery Hall

After climbing 63 stairs, an imposing hall awaits guests in the open-work lacework bell tower of the Matthias Church, designed by Frigyes Schulek. Reflecting the style of the Matthias Church, the hall is a beautiful venue for small-scale events.



St. Stephen's Basilica Knight's Hall

The brick walls of the 114 sqm Knight's Hall of St. Stephen's Basilica provide a rustic atmosphere for various events. Thus, fine art exhibitions, chamber concerts, press conferences and other cultural events can also find a home here. In addition to liturgical events, the Basilica's church hall with seating provided for nearly 800 people is also the venue for classical music concerts, where groups can also request 15 to 30-minute organ concerts. The tunes of the large organ combined with the spectacular views of the church create a wonderful experience.

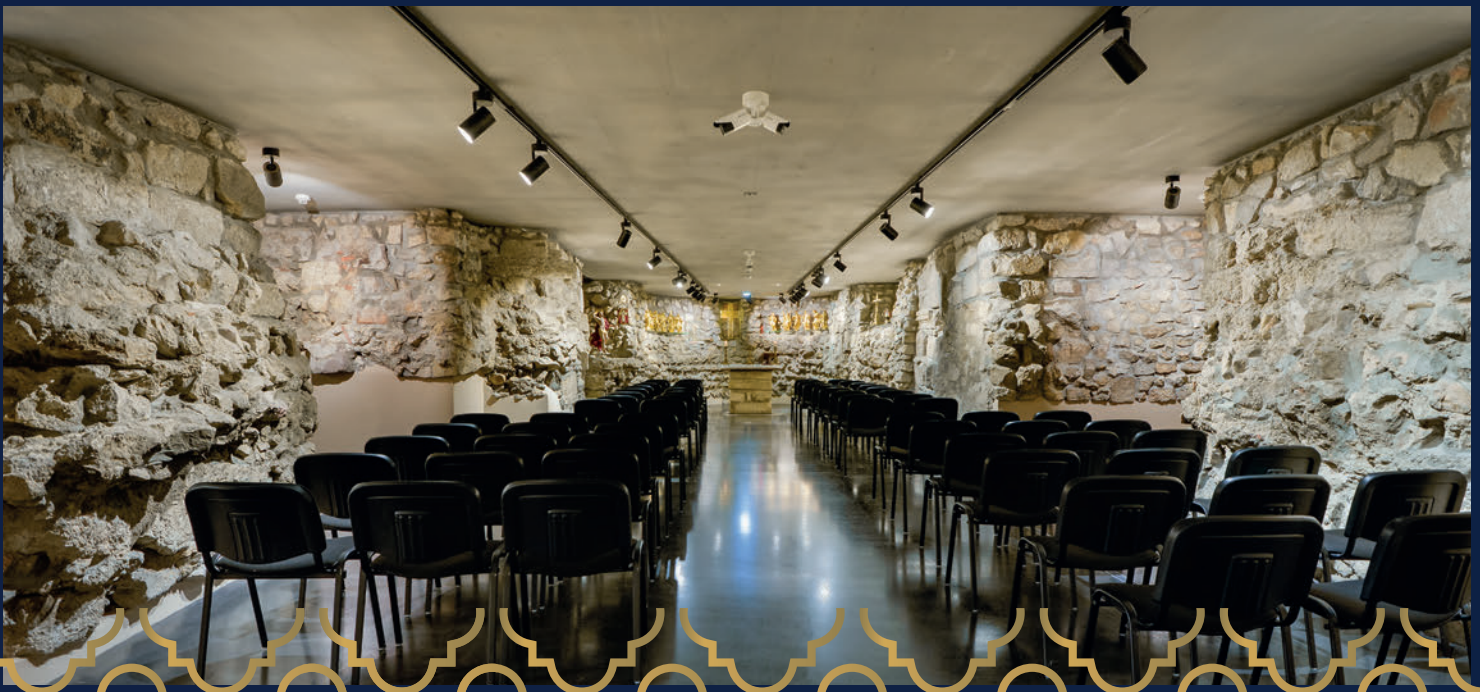



Undercroft of St. Francis of Assisi Parish Church

With a capacity of almost 100 people, the beautiful undercroft with its original stars-painted decoration, is a special venue for artistic events, cultural programmes, performances and even for wine tastings.

Undercroft of the Inner-City Parish Church

The undercroft of the church, built on the remains of buildings from the Roman period and surrounded by foundation walls from the 11th and 12th centuries, provides the perfect venue for press conferences, cultural events, and music programs.
